WDFW and NWS are both interested in long-term data. The attached map shows the survey results for July for the entire region. Note that the lion's share of positive locations is in Island County. The map reflects sampling by multiple entities.

Pigeon Guillemot Survey (Wood): Update at meeting.


Other Reports
